



THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF NEW YORK; TO ALL TO WHOM THESE PRESENTS SHALL COME:

WHEREAS, At a Court held in and for the County of Westchester, Anthony Papa was convicted by a jury trial of Criminal Sale of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree, and Criminal Possession of a Controlled Substance in the First Degree, and was thereupon sentenced to be imprisoned for a term of imprisonment with a minimum of two concurrent terms of fifteen years to a maximum of life, under which convictions and sentences thereupon the said inmate is now imprisoned in the Sing Sing Correctional Facility, and it being represented unto me that it is proper to commute or change the said minimum sentence to a lesser period:

THEREFORE KNOW YE, That by these presents I do hereby commute the said minimum sentence of imprisonment for the term of eleven years, eleven months, and fourteen days, without commutation or compensation, which minimum term will terminate the twenty-third day of December, 1996.

This commutation is granted upon the express condition that if said Anthony Papa shall be hereafter convicted of any felony committed within five years from the date of his discharge by reason hereof, he shall be deemed an escaped convict with respect to the said sentence and, in addition to the sentence which may be imposed for the felony committed during the period aforesaid and before commencement of such sentence, he shall be compelled to serve in the prison or penitentiary in which he may be confined for such felony, or if not confined therefor in any prison or penitentiary, then in one of the New York State correctional institutions, the full minimum term of fifteen years remaining unserved on the date of his discharge by reason hereof, without deduction or commutation for good behavior; and on the further express condition that the said inmate shall live and remain at liberty without violating the law and that for the balance of the aforesaid maximum term the said inmate shall remain subject to the supervision, jurisdiction and control of the Board of Parole of the State of New York and subject to all of its rules and regulations in the same manner as a prisoner on parole under the provisions of the Executive Law.
